Rhein Class-Spring Term 1

Place value & number: Count, read and write forwards and backwards to 50 (Y1); represent numbers and ones and tens; compare groups and numbers using symbols and correct vocabulary for addition and subtraction.

Multiplication & Division (Y2): making equal groups, making and calculating with arrays. Learning the 2-, 5- and 10-times tables. Dividing by 2, 5 and 10. Recognising coins and calculating with money.

English: Learning to read as a writer and write as a reader. Exploring the effective use of language and the choices that the author makes. Improving inference skills by digging deeper for answers which are less obvious.

Writing to inform by writing instructional texts. Writing to entertain through exploring poems to talk about Karneval.

Working together to develop a love for reading.

Science: Identifying materials and their properties; Shaping materials; Uses of materials; Linking properties to use; Sustainability and recycling; Working scientifically – Identifying and classifying, Pattern seeking, Comparative

Plant parts; Seasonal changes in plants; Investigating germination; Investigating plant growth; Unusual plants; Working scientifically – Observing changes over time, Identifying and classifying, Pattern seeking, Comparative

DT: Evaluating existing products and how they work. Designing and making their own beach hut.
